

Garmin GPS and BaseCamp – How to do it



You will need:

- A **Garmin GPS** With **LM** (Lifetime maps updates) so you can keep your GPS device updated with the latest map.
- **Garmin Express**, which is the software that allows you to update your GPS device. Link to [Garmin ExPress](#) software.

- **Garmin BaseCamp**, which is the software you will need to transfer *. GPX file for your GPS. Here you can also see the routes on a map.

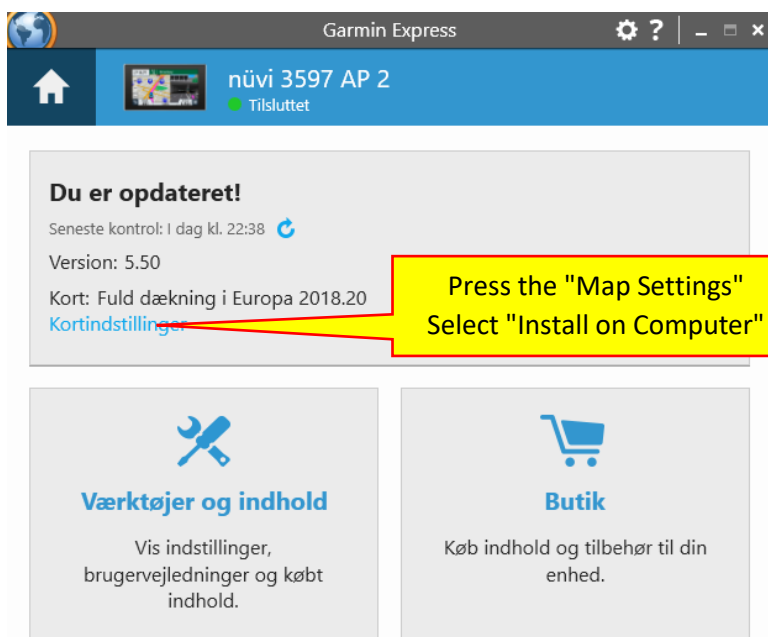

Update your map and install maps on your computer.

Garmin Express opens automatically when you connect your GPS device



Make sure your Garmin GPS device is up to date.

You also have the option to install the card on your computer.

Garmin BaseCamp

Check the version of the map that is installed

Detail level of maps on your screen on your PC

When your Garmin GPS device is connected, you can see it in the left menu

You can see if there are additional memory cards

BaseCamp must be prepared before you can transfer the files

1. Tap "My Collection"
2. Right-click and you get menu
3. Create "new List Folder"

Garmin BaseCamp – How to do it



5. Press the "Your new List Folder"

6. Right-click and you get new options

6. Create "New list"

You should make the same number of lists as there are files (new list for new routes)

One can well import multiple files in the same "list"

The routes are preserved, but waypoints are mixed

Now Garmin BaseCamp is ready
Now you only need to receive some files with the routes.

Open your email – Save Attachments

1. Press "File"

2. Select "Save Attachments"

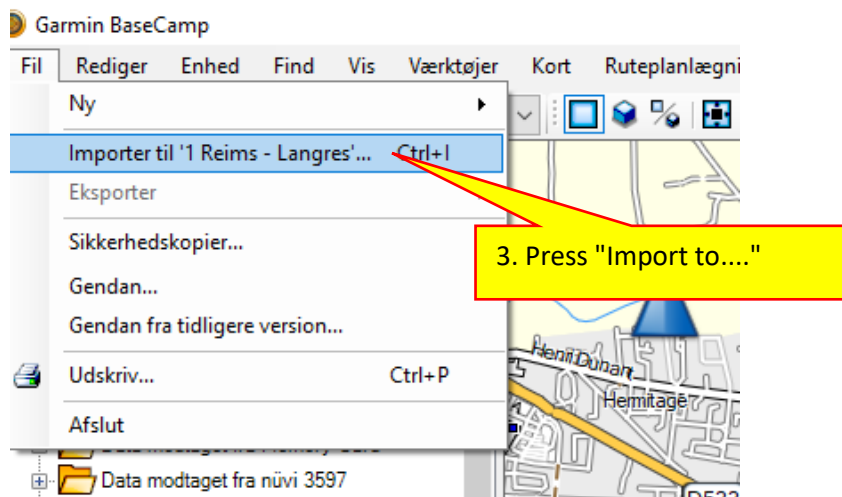
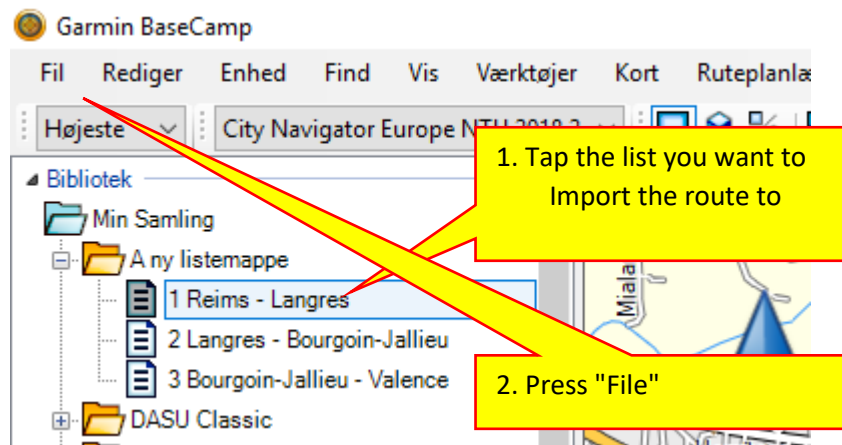
3. Press "OK"

4. Select a folder and save

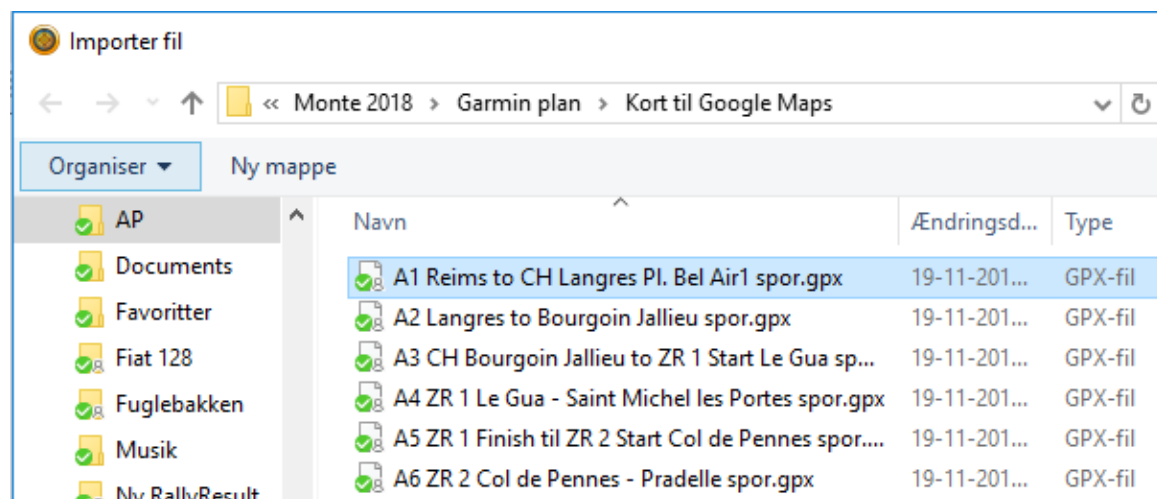

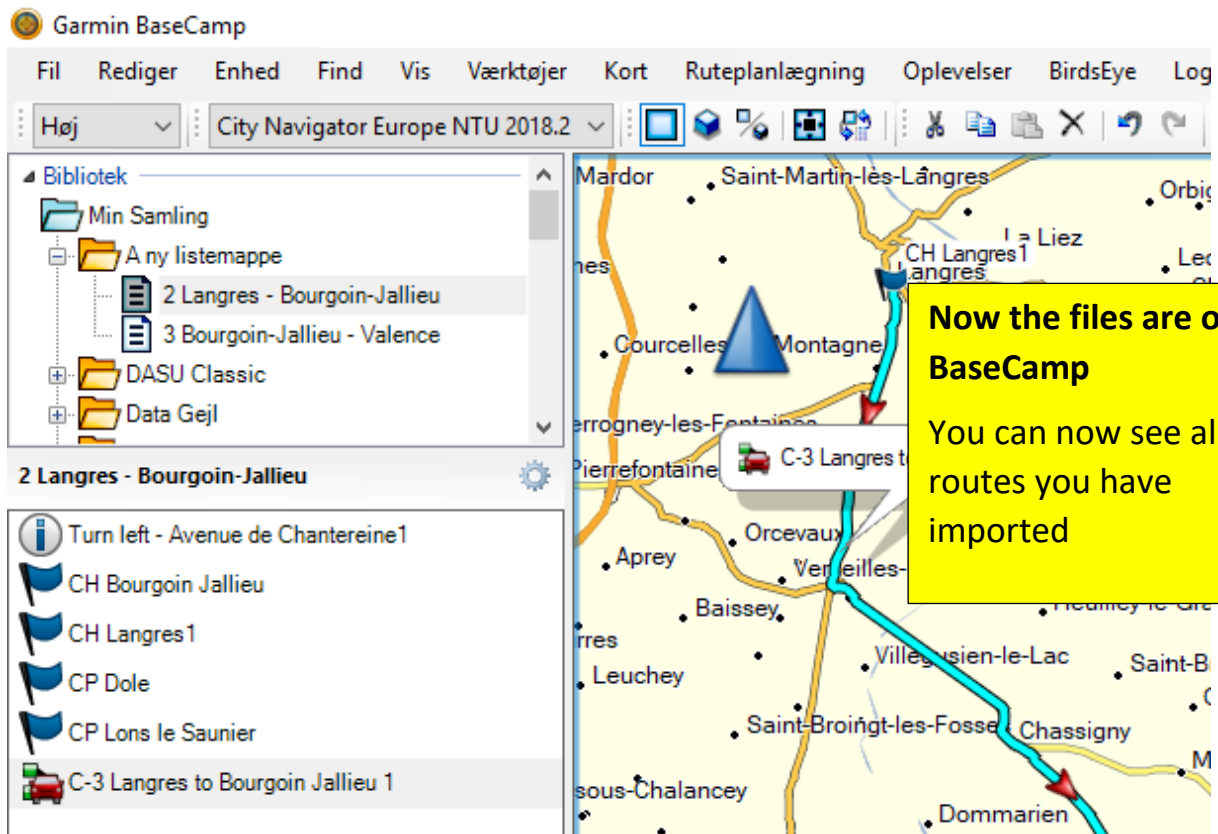
Now you are ready to import GPX files to BaseCamp



File Explorer opens, and you select the folder where you saved the files. Now you select the file you want to insert in BaseCamp (press Open or double-click)

Transfer selected routes to the Garmin GPS



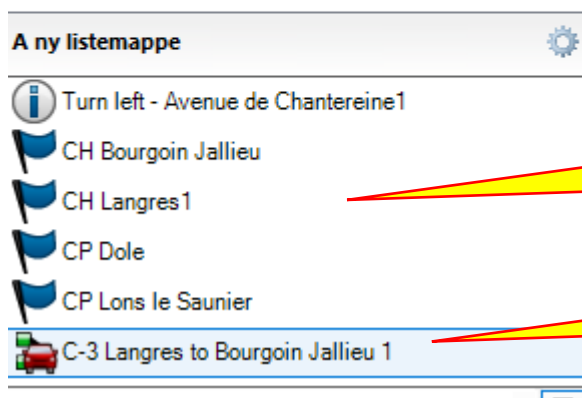
Garmin GPS and BaseCamp – How to do it



1-Garmin GPS Connected

2- Open BaseCamp

In the left menu you can now see that your Garmin is connected



Waypoints

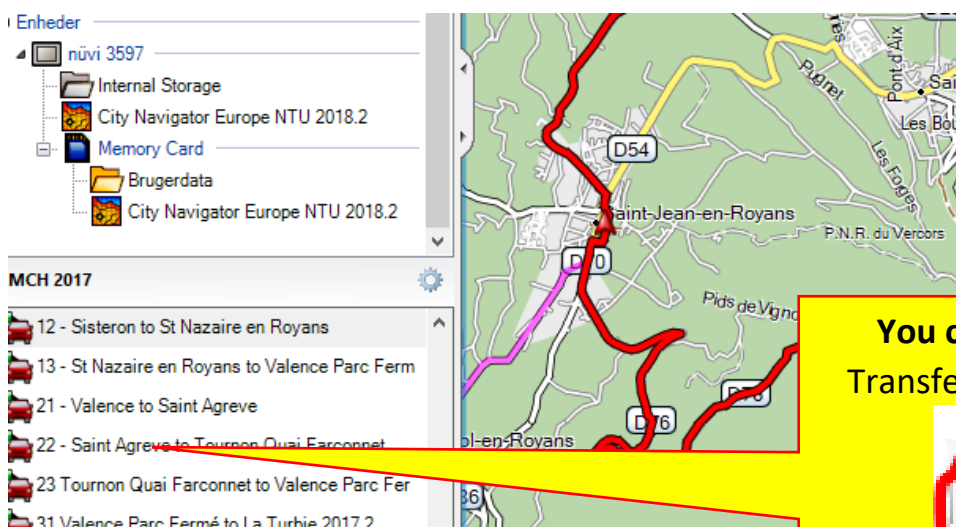
Single spot

Route

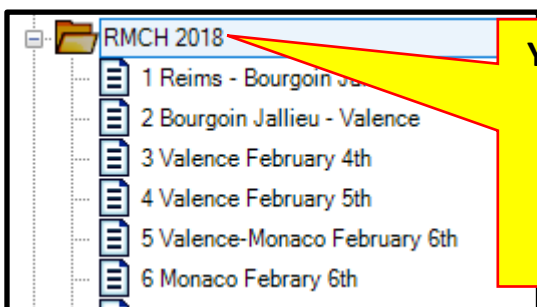
Programmed Route



Select the desired route – or multiple routes – press icon



You can select a route
Transfer to the GPS device



You can select the entire race
Transfer to the GPS device

**Start your Garmin GPS- but have patience when you will see the new routes
Garmin GPS is slow – it is recommended to connect external power and let it rest**
